Could find no pupfish.
In channel through downstream island were carp & what looked like Moxostoma in shallow water (backs often exposed) In back water of same channel were many Dianda (breeding?) Many dead. Also some of dead were Pimephales (?) - white bodies, yellow fins & inferior mouth.

Caught large N. venustus, N. amabilis & Dorosoma in channel near road crossing.

Caught F. grandis looking Fundulus along with the F. kansae, could get no riffle-type fish (Etheostoma, etc) in the riffles.

Guts of one large carp contained 4 fish (at least 2 Dianda). One was 60 mm. body (no skull) Other was 14 mm from hyp. to post. base of dorsal.

~2.5 times as much animal as veg. matter.
